

Singapore International Violin Competition postponed to January 2022

In light of the global COVID-19 pandemic situation, the Singapore International Violin Competition – originally scheduled to take place from 17-29 January 2021 – will be postponed by a year to 16-28 January 2022.

Given that preparations had been well under way, the decision took much deliberation – applications were already open, the Commissioned Work had been selected and announced, and partnerships had been established. However, given health and safety considerations as well as complexities regarding international travel and live events, the Artistic Committee decided that it would be best to reschedule the competition so as to ensure an optimal event for candidates, jury and audience members alike.

The new competition dates will be as follows, and application details will be announced in due course.

First Rounds: 16-20 January 2022 Semi-Finals: 22-23 January 2022

Finals: 25-26 January 2022 (at Victoria Concert Hall)

Grand Finals: 28 January 2022 (at Esplanade Concert Hall with the Singapore Symphony Orchestra).

In line with the original eligibility criteria, the 2022 competition will continue to be open to violinists of all nationalities born after 31 December 1990. Candidates who had already submitted applications may update their materials.
